<u>Time</u>: The time and days when the class meets.

Re Student: The name of the student reported.

<u>ID Number</u>: The student's ID number. <u>Report Date</u>: Date this report is filled.

<u>Section No</u>: The section number for which this form is filled. <u>Classroom No</u>: Location of the class where the students meet.

Exam Grade: Student grade for the given subject.

<u>Class Average</u>: Overall average for the students in the given class.

Table Legend:

1. This is how the teacher views the student's academic behavior in class. 5 indicates that the student cooperates and participates during the class. 3 indicates that that student is quiet in the class, while 1 indicates he/she are disruptive to the class.

- 2. This is how the teacher views the student's behavior in class. 5 indicates that the student cooperates and participates during the class. 3 indicates that that student is quiet in the class, while 1 indicates he/she are disruptive to the class.
- 3. This indicates the student's attendance record. 5 means that the student has an excessive absence close or over the maximum allowed, while 1 means no absence.
- 4. This is a reflection of the student's grade according to the following table.

Mark	To Represent

2	60-69%
3	70-79%
4	80-89%
5	90-100%

5. This is an indicator of how consistent the student has been with his/her behavior. 5 means that the student's work (bad or good) has been the same. 1 means that it changes all the time
