Scholarships:

Attended students at Philadelphia university have a chance to earn many scholarships that encourage their academic and nonacademic accomplishments at different fields such as sport, crafts, art and social services,

Examples:

- Academic excellence Scholarships.
- Scholarships of excellence in high school in the scientific and literary branches provide a grant equivalent to 20% of the tuition fees for children of members of professional unions.
- Reduction of fees for the first year.
- Sibling scholarships.
- Sport excellence.

Admission Policy:

Male and Female students who hold a Jordanian secondary school certificate or its equivalent at a rate of not less than 70% are accepted at the College of Nursing. In addition, the school accepts students in the bridging program based on the higher education laws & regulation related to the equivalence of the diploma certificate. Or what is equivalent to it from neighboring Arab countries.

Synopsis

The Faculty of Nursing was established in the academic year 2004/2005 with the aim of graduating registered male and female nurses Holding a bachelor's degree in nursing, and to meet the increasing needs of Jordanian Society of nursing competencies.

The Faculty adopts an integrated educational plan including theoretical and practical courses. And it cares about the recruitment of highly-qualified academic staff members to implement the educational plan as well as the practical and applied activities at the university and the local community. A number of well-qualified bachelor's degree holders have been appointed as instructors to carry out the process of students practical and field training. The Faculty has academic staff members who hold doctoral degrees in various nursing specializations from top world universities, in addition to master's degree holders. The Faculty campus houses spacious classrooms, a cafeteria, a place of prayer, a comprehensive health center and an auditorium that seats 250 people.



Study system:

The Faculty applies the credit-hour system. Course hours are distributed over four years. The academic year falls into two mandatory semesters (first and second) 16 weeks each, in addition to an optional summer session for 8 weeks.

The maximum course load for the student in every semester is 18 credit hours per mandatory semester and 9 hours per the summer / optional session. English is used as the medium of instruction for all courses at the Faculty.

University fees are divided into tuition and registration fees:

Educational fees:

(50) JD per credit hour.

University Registration Fees:

(45) JD dinars application for the first time.

(50) JD dinars refundable insurance fee paid once.

(355) JD Registration fees for each semester (first semester, second semester)

(255) JD registration fees summer semester services

To be one of the Jordanian Faculties which are distinguished in nursing education and learning; Scientific research and community service according to international standards



Labs & Practical Training

Students receive practical training in different places such as hospitals, health centers and local community institutions. This training is carried out in area accredit from HEAC such as public, private hospitals and public health service centers. Training takes place two days a week, 7 hours a day for each three-credit hour's course. Students of the Faculty of Nursing end the program by taking the four-credit hour training's course attending practical working hours at any location in hospitals. This training acquires skills that are required to help students to be a professional nurse after graduation to meet the needs of field work.
