

*International cooperation projects based on **multilateral partnerships** between **organisations active in the field of VET in Programme countries and Third countries not associated to the Programme***

*They aim to **support the relevance, accessibility, and responsiveness of VET institutions and systems** as a driver of sustainable socio-economic development*





Objectives




- ✓ Reinforce the **links between the VET system** of the Third countries not associated to the Programme **and its labour market**
- ✓ Increase the **link between VET profiles** and **local/regional/national strategies and priorities impacted by skills**
- ✓ Increase the **capacities of VET providers**
- ✓ Support the **exposure of staff, managers, policy makers and senior teachers to approaches bringing the labour market and VET closer**
- ✓ Improve the **knowledge, technical, managerial and pedagogical skills of VET teachers and trainers**
- ✓ Integrate the **input from teachers/trainers, VET learners and employers into curriculum, profile design and training reform**
- ✓ Improve the level of competences, skills and employability potential of VET learners by **developing new and innovative VET education programmes**
- ✓ Foster **cooperation across different regions of the world through joint initiatives**

Who can be the Applicant?

*Any **public or private organisation active in VET and legally established in a Programme country** (EU Member State or country associated to the Programme)*





Who can participate?



Any public or private **VET provider** or **organisation active in VET or in the labour market** and legally established in a Programme country or in an **eligible Third country** not associated to the Programme can be involved as **full partner**, affiliated entity or associated partner

Any public or private **organisation contributing to the implementation of specific project tasks/activities or support the dissemination and sustainability of the project** can be involved as associated partner





Number and Profile of Participating Organizations



*The partnership must include at least **4 full partners** from a minimum of **3 countries**:*

*At least **1 organisation** from **2 different EU Member States and Third countries associated to the Programme** and a least **2 organisations** from at least **1 eligible Third country not associated to the Programme***

The number of organisations from EU Member States and Third countries associated to the Programme may not be higher than the number of organisations from Third countries not associated to the Programme





Activities

Project activities must focus on **building and strengthening the capacities of organisations active in the field of VET** principally in the **Third countries not associated to the Programme**

Funded projects will be able to integrate a wide range of cooperation, exchange, communication and other activities including for example:

- ✓ Creating and developing **networks and exchanges of good practice**
- ✓ Creating **tools, programmes and other materials** to build capacity
- ✓ Creating **mechanisms to involve the private sector both in the design and delivery of curricula and to provide VET learners with high quality work-based experience**
- ✓ Developing and transferring **pedagogical approaches, teaching and training materials and methods**
- ✓ Developing and implementing **international (virtual) exchange activities for staff**

Duration: 1, 2 or 3 years

- ✓ *Review and impact assessment*

and participation*

Quality of the partnership and the cooperation arrangements	20	10
Impact	20	10

Erasmus+ has an estimated budget of **€26.2 billion***, nearly doubling the funding compared to its predecessor programme (2014-2020), considered by around **€2.2 billion** from the EU external cooperation instrument¹.

Erasmus+ mobility has positive effects on educational, social, personal and professional development, in that it enhances knowledge, skills and attitudes, it improves employability, helps confidence-building and independence, stimulates curiosity and innovation, fosters the understanding of other people, and builds a sense of European belonging.

30% of the budget will be invested in cooperation projects and policy development activities where operators gain experience in international cooperation, strengthen their capacities, produce innovative approaches, exchange good practices and networks. Through these actions, Erasmus+ will play an important role in strengthening resilience and supporting recovery and innovation in the fields of education, training, youth and sport.

70% of the budget will support mobility opportunities for all, in a lifelong learning perspective.

* The Erasmus+ programme budget is made of €24.734 billion in current prices as well as the new MFF (2021-2027) and an additional top-up of €1.466 billion in 2024 prices.
¹ Neighbourhood, Development and Cooperation Instrument (NDICI) and the Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA).
