





Introduction

What is Erasmus+?


- The EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport
- Funding for programmes, projects and scholarships
- Fosters EU-EU and EU-international cooperation
- Erasmus+ programme 2021-2027:
 - ➤ builds on previous programme
 - >more international



• The application for it should be done by the European partner







Activities supported (I)

- Short-term higher education mobility for students, academic and administrative staff
- All levels: Bachelor, Master and PhD candidates
- Mobility in any subject or academic discipline
- Also supports traineeships for students and training for staff
- Study periods and traineeships of 2 12 months
- Blended mobility (physical mobility of 5 30 days + virtual component)







Activities supported (II)

- All partners in an ICM project can send and host students and staff as described in their submitted project and provided that a relevant grant has been secured.
- For certain countries, Bachelor/Master student mobility is only possible from third countries to Europe – this means third country universities can send but not host.
- Countries with this restriction can be found in this list (Region 1 Western Balkans is exempted from restriction): https://www.oecd.org/dac/financing-sustainable-development/development-finance-standards/DAC-List-ODA-Recipients-for-reporting-2021-flows.pdf
- European partners may use a part of their intra-European mobility budget to fund their students mobility to restricted countries under ICM.







Organisational support

EUR 500/participant

Individual support

EUR 700-900/month for students and EUR 140-180/day for staff

EUR 70/day up to the 14th day of activity and EUR 50/day from 15th to the 30th day of activity in case of blended mobility



Contribution to travel costs

EUR 20-1500, depending on distance travelled






Who can apply and how? (I)

- · Higher Education Institutions in the Programme countries
- The ICM project in their application contains the countries and partner universities they intend to cooperate with, as well as their cooperation plan in each region

International Credit Mobility (ICM) in the new Erasmus+ programme: novelties (I)

Application form – regional approach:



- 3 quality questions: one at project level and two for each region the applicant intends to cooperate with
- Apply only for student/staff mobility without specifying types of activity (studies/ traineeships or teaching/training)
- Shift funds between countries in the same region => more flexible budget management
- Estimation of participants with fewer opportunities





International Credit Mobility (ICM) in the new Erasmus+ programme: novelties (II)

Enhanced opportunities with a focus on inclusion:



- blended mobilities short physical mobility of 5 to 30 days combined with a virtual component,
- opening up to recent graduates for traineeships,
- > flexible format for doctoral candidates





ICM in the new Erasmus+ programme: novelties (III)


- · Individual and travel support contributions will remain the same:
 - . EUR 700-900/month for students and EUR 140-180/day for staff
 - Physical activity as part of blended mobility: EUR 70/day up to the 14th day of activity and EUR 50/day from 15th to the 30th day of activity
- Increased OS from EUR 350 to 500 per participant
- Top-ups for participants with fewer opportunities and special organisational support to HEIs
- Top-up for green travel








What is an EMDM project?



- ✓ Short duration grant to support institutions in the set-up of a new joint master programme in Europe (and beyond)
- ✓ One beneficiary mobilising a group of other HEIs
- ✓ Independent funding scheme from EMJM (independent calls for proposals)
