Administering Users and Groups



Adding Accounts

- `sudo adduser testuser ;; su testuser ;; id`

- Files and the directory involved

- `/etc/login.defs`

It contains directives for use in various shadow password suite commands.

- `/etc/skel` ; e.g. `/etc/skel/Desktop/Giude.txt`

holds files, to be copied to the user account's home directory when the account is created

- `/etc/passwd`

It contains a single line data for each account

- `/etc/shadow`

It contains information regarding the account's password

- `/etc/group`

Managing Accounts

- Modifying password

`sudo passwd testuser`

- Viewing password settings

`sudo chage -l testuser`

- Deleting user account

`sudo userdel testuser` (-r delete account's home directory and any files within it)

- Viewing user record in a file

`sudo getent passwd testuser`

`sudo getent shadow testuser`

Managing Groups

- Creating group

```
sudo groupadd testgroup
```

- Group membership

```
sudo usermod -aG testgroup testuser
```

- Deleting Group

```
sudo groupdel testgroup
```

Querying Access Status of Users

- `whoami`
displays what user account you are currently using
- `Who`
shows all the current system users, the terminal they are using, the date and time they entered the system, and in cases of remote users, their remote IP address
- `w`
provides more details than the `who` command
