

Exercise 2: Forms _ HTML

- In the form below, add an input field with the type "button" and the value "OK".

```
<form>  
< ..... >  
</form>
```

- In the form below, add two radio buttons, both with the name "Jordan".

```
<form>  
< ..... value="html"> HTML  
< ..... value="css"> CSS  
</form>
```

- Add a submit button, and specify that the form should go to "/action_page.php".

```
<form ..... ="/action_page.php">  
Name: <input type="text" name="name">  
< ..... >  
</form>
```

- In the form below, add two option elements to the drop down list.

- The first option must have the value "Volvo"
- The second option must have the value "Ford".

```
<form action="/action_page.php">  
<select name="cars">  
< ..... >Volvo< ..... >  
< ..... >Ford< ..... >  
</select>  
</form>
```

- In the form below, add a text area with the name "note".

```
<form action="/action_page.php">  
< ..... >< ..... >  
</form>
```

- In the form below, add an input field for text, with the name "username" .

```
<form action="/action_page.php">  
< .....>  
</form>
```

- In the form below, add a submit button with the value "Submit Form".

```
<form action="/action_page.php">  
<input type="text" name="username">  
<input ..... >  
</form>
```

- In the form below, add a input field for button with the value "Click Me".
