What is Test Automation?

— Make the test procedures to be executed automatically

Why Test Automation?

- Make the testing procedures systematic and consistent.
- O Minimize the error-prone manual testing
- Save effort of QA Engineer: fast, in the night and short testing cycle
- O Some testing is not able to be done manually
