A. Reading Comprehension (8 points)

In the American educational system, any student may attend a free public school from kindergarten (at about age five) through twelfth grade (about age eighteen). These public schools are all coeducational; boys and girls study together in the same class.

When students are in high school, they begin to plan for college. Although many courses are required for all students, some courses are electives; students choose them.

For example, if a student wants to be prepared for college, he or she might choose to take chemistry, physics, an advanced mathematics class, or an advanced foreign language class. A student who doesn't plan to go to college might take auto mechanics, welding, or woodworking. After-school activities such as sports, drama, music, and student government are important both to students who are preparing for college and to those who aren't.

Just as there is a great variety of courses at the college level, there is also a great variety of instructors. Many instructors are quite formal; they expect to be called by their title and last name ('Professor Adams,'' 'Ms. Thompson,'' 'Mr. Kramer''). They stand in front of the class and give formal lectures during which students take notes. Although they don't expect students to stand up when the instructor enters the room or when answering a question, they do appear to be very serious. Other instructors are informal; they prefer to be called by their first names. They might sit on the desk and expect students to participate in discussion with them. They try to make class enjoyable and sometimes joke with students. This informality, however, doesn't mean that they are not serious about teaching. They still expect students to study, do the homework, and do well on exams.

Cheating (using another student's answer on, for example, a quiz or test) is considered to be very improper, and it is taken seriously by all instructors. A student who has cheated on an exam will probably receive an "F" and might be dismissed from school.
